Proposed Research Dates

Fellowships may be held between July 15, 2008 and June 30, 2009. Awards generally are granted for 1-2 months; additional months may be proposed and will be awarded depending upon budget availability. Please give the exact dates of research in your cover letter.

Applications must also include:

- A signed cover letter that includes a statement explaining the applicant's interest in the program, eligibility criteria, length of the fellowship requested, preferred dates of the fellowship.
- An abstract, not to exceed 300 words, that defines the topic of the proposed research and summarize its objectives.
- A research proposal, no more than 6 pages in length, that describes what is to be accomplished during the fellowship period; the status of the applicant's research on the proposed research topic; the specific relevance of the archives' and collections chosen; the significance of the research to the advancement of an understanding and an appreciation of New Mexico history; and the expected results of the research.
- A curriculum vitae, (no longer than 4 pages).
- Copies of certified transcripts (students) or diplomas.
- Two letters of recommendation. If the applicant is a graduate student enrolled in a Ph.D. program, one of the letters must be from the applicant's dissertation chair or advisor. If the applicant is enrolled in a master's degree program, one of the letters must be from the student's graduate advisor.

The cover letter, the abstract, the proposal and the curriculum vitae will be produced in 12-point type and will be double spaced, with one inch margins on all sides. The applications must be collated with five copies attached.
